DEPARTMENTS

The Leslie-Lohman Museum offers experience in the following departments:

COLLECTIONS

Assist in the preservation, documentation, and maintenance of the Museum's Permanent Collection and Study Collection.

EXHIBITIONS

Promote the Museum's mission related to programs including exhibitions, lectures, workshops, talks, films, community programming and other activities, including the publication of The Archive.

MARKETING & COMMUNICATIONS

Support the Museum's external communications and marketing of programs and exhibitions, including development and fundraising.

RESEARCH

Conduct independent research for upcoming exhibitions and programs.

The Museum also offers a rotating program that offers work in all departments.
